# Post Prom

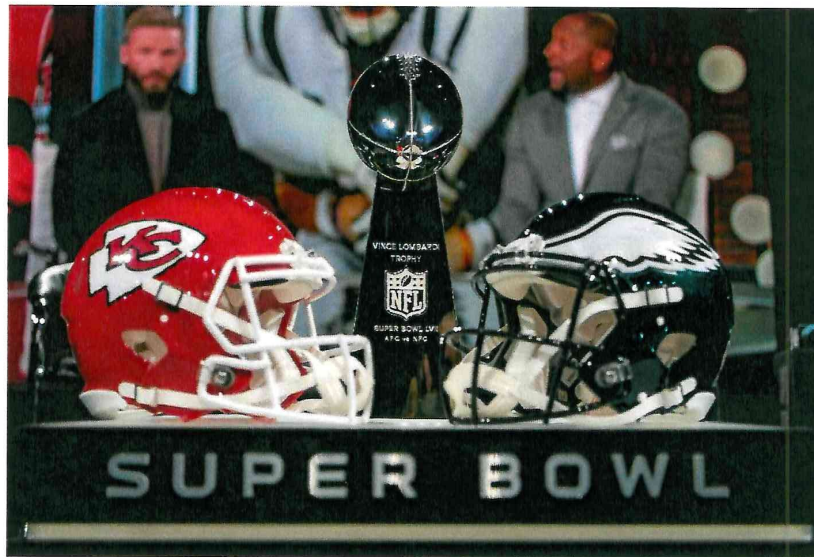

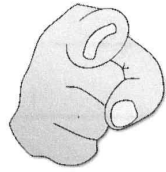
